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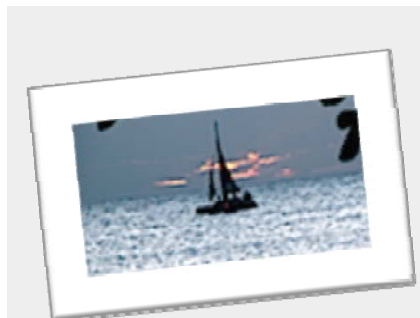
## *Catamaran Sailing Charters*—on the **Katrina Catamaran**

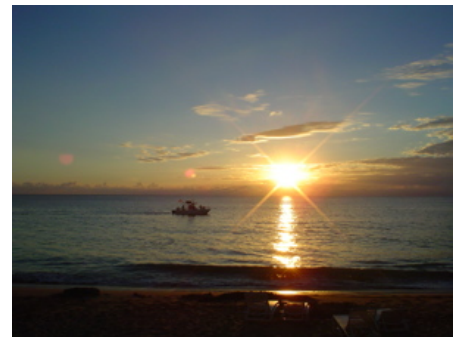

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# Site Seeing

Rincón, known as “Puerto Rico’s best beach town,” sits on the island’s most westerly point, framed by blue water, green mountains and golden sand. This little fishing village was quite literally “not on the map” until the famed surfing championships of ’68 brought renown to its world-class waves. Today, far from the non-stop bustle of San Juan, this laid-back surfer’s mecca has a vibe all its own. Rincón tempts visitors out of their sun chairs with a full spectrum of vacation diversions, appealing to all ages. The town’s motto: “Surf, Dive, Explore, Eat, Drink, Party, Relax, Start Over,” says it all; and of course visitors can concentrate on their favorites from the list, too!

Minimalists may choose to beach comb or hike all day, with long stretches of wide beach and tropical nature trails to explore. Surfers of every skill level can find their perfect wave, and non-surfers can enjoy the show from a beachfront tikki bar. Thanks to Rincon’s plentiful offshore reefs, those who’d rather be under the waves than on them, can find great diving near Rincón’s offshore islands ,or snorkeling, right off the town’s quieter south-facing beaches. From Rincón’s El Faro Lighthouse, built to help boats steer past the coastline’s reefs, visitors can take in the spectacular beauty of the shore and mountains. In the winter months, this spot offers the perfect vantage point for humpback whale watching.

Sports lovers adore Rincón and its surrounds, for the unlimited array of activities to choose from. Besides surfing and diving – with lessons available for all – there is deep sea fishing, sailing, kayaking and parasailing. On land, you can choose, golf, minigolf (in nearby Aguadilla), tennis, bike or horseback riding. And, if your favorite game involves dice, there’s a casino a short drive away.

Nature lovers can take in the many lakes on the West Coast or, climb a trail into the coastal mountains to catch great panoramic views. An hour or two south brings you to more natural wonders, including La Parguera Phosphorescent Bay, and bird watching and guided trails in remarkable Guanica State Forest, the greatest dry forest reserve in the Caribbean . Eco-tourists cannot miss the 2.5 hour drive, starting out east along the Ruta Panorámica, which leads you to the route to El Yunque, the only virgin tropical rainforest in the U.S.
